Description: A presentation to introduce interior glazing options and their characteristics.

Learning Objectives: (1) Understanding glazing limitations using GANA (Glass Association of North America) standards and guidelines to evaluate if a specified product is adequate for given design. (2) Define decorative glazing using existing projects to illustrate options and uses on the interior of a building. (3) Present new developments in specialty glazing products using completed projects to define current technologies available. (4) Explain three basic components of fire protection as it relates to glazing using manufacturers test data to appropriately identify product selection in an application.

How Taught: The CES facilitator utilizes a PowerPoint presentation to introduce various glazing products and their applications/uses in interior construction. Many product samples are on display and passed around as hands on examples.

Target Audience: Architects, specifiers, owners, general contractors, and other industry specific professionals. The ideal audience size can be one on one or up to 30. This program meets all experience levels. Time is designated for a question and answer session.

Facilitator Qualifications: All Trainor Glass CES facilitators have been trained on CES guidelines and presentation material. Including 40 hours mandatory industry related training per year.
