Description: A presentation to introduce moveable/demountable interior partitions and their characteristics in relation to sustainable design.

Learning Objectives: (1) Explain three sustainable design advantages of demountable partitions. (2) Differentiate the two most common assembly methods for demountable partitions and identify the most eco-friendly method. (3) Recognize schedule characteristics of demountable partition systems and discuss how schedule relates to sustainability. (4) Identify and differentiate at least four performance characteristics of demountable partitions and how these affect the surrounding environment.

How Taught: The CES facilitator utilizes a PowerPoint presentation to introduce various demountable/moveable partition systems, their characteristics and their relation to sustainable design. Product samples are put on display and passed around as hands-on examples.

Target Audience: Architects, specifiers, owners, general contractors, owner representatives, interior designers and other industry specific professionals. Ideal audience can be anywhere from one to thirty people. This program meets all experience levels. Time is designated for a question and answer session.
