Description: A presentation on the methods and materials that can be used in re-cladding existing buildings using glass and aluminum material, contributing to increasing of property values, creating a more inviting building user environment, and incorporating sustainable design elements.

Learning Objectives: (1) Aesthetic improvement options to existing buildings. Introduction of options to improve existing building exteriors and interiors through the use and addition of new materials within as well as replacing existing building conditions. (2) Upgrades in building efficiency and energy conservation. Description and education of how modern materials incorporated into existing construction can improve building energy costs and conservation. (3) Improvements in health, safety and welfare of building occupants. In addition to the improvements in aesthetics and energy conservation, how introduction of exterior light and improved energy efficiencies improve environmental experience of the building users. (4) Cost effectiveness versus new construction. How using the existing structure, or minimal additions of new structure to existing buildings along with new façade, glass and wall components can create a 'new building' look and performance at a lower cost than new construction.

How Taught: The CES facilitator utilizes a PowerPoint presentation to thoroughly review the various roles glazing and the exterior fenestration contractor plays in re-cladding existing interior and exterior spaces. It follows an outline of procedures, products and typical construction methods used. Product samples may be provided for display and passed around as hands on examples.

Target Audience: Architects, specifiers, owners, general contractors, and other industry specific professionals. The ideal audience size can be one on one or up to 30. This program meets all experience levels. Time is designated for a question and answer session.

Facilitator Qualifications: All Trainor Glass CES facilitators have been trained on CES guidelines and presentation material. Including 40 hours mandatory industry related training per year.
